

2024 US Open Ticket Prices - How to Spot a Good Deal?

The top question I get every year: "Will prices go up or down? Should I wait or buy now?"

Unfortunately, there's no easy answer. It depends on many unpredictable variables – the most important being who ultimately gets scheduled for any given session. And pricing of some sessions historically tend to be less variable (or less "elastic") than others: for instance, prices of Week 1's Friday Day session through the Monday Day session of Labor Day weekend tend not to go down and sometimes go up as we get closer, as there is always very heavy demand regardless of who's playing given the massive influx of tourists in town. Quarterfinal Day sessions tend to go down in price almost every year closer to the date, whereas Quarterfinal Evening session pricing usually stays pretty high (ditto Men's Semifinal evening session).

One of the best indicators to make educated guesses about whether prices will go up or down for any given session is the number of unsold tickets available for a given session: the sessions with the most tickets available are the ones where prices may go down, whereas those with more scarcity may see average prices stay or go up.

In general, it pays to have patience and flexibility, because good deals often emerge very close to the actual date of play (including the day of!) when resellers have to lower prices to get something back for their tickets. However, when superstars or amazing match-ups are scheduled, prices can skyrocket. For instance, average prices in July for the Men's Final session may be stratospheric with fans imagining a possible Djokovic/Alcaraz match-up; but if either or both lose in earlier rounds, average Men's Final prices would likely drop dramatically.

MY TOP ADVICE: The best thing to do is keep monitoring prices on [Ticketmaster](#) for sessions to become familiar with pricing trends for sessions that interest you so you can make an informed decision based on your budget.

HOW CAN I SPOT A GOOD DEAL? WHAT ARE AVERAGE PRICES PER SESSION?

Below are my notes on what I'd consider roughly a "good deal" (including fees) for each session/ticket type. The estimates are based on this year's average prices and my tracking of the past two years' pricing trends for both standard and resale tickets. Keep in mind these are only rough estimations, given so many fluctuations and the complicating factor that the US Open does not post Standard ("face value") ticket prices and allows even those tickets to go up and down due to variable pricing on [Ticketmaster](#). But hopefully they're a starting point to help you gauge expectations as you explore and make the right decisions for you.

How to read the numbers in the chart:

- “< \$XXX” means anything under \$XXX would be a good deal, with XXX the approximate minimum amount to expect to pay for a seat in this section.
- “\$XXX-\$YYY” is the approximate range for good deals within this section, with XXX the approximate minimum amount (anything below a very good deal) and \$YYY a good deal for the best seats in the section. Note: I do not list the upper end of ticket ranges (which may be hundreds or even thousands of dollars higher for Courtside Ashe), only the range for what I think a good deal would be.

*** Note: There is no rational reason why prices are higher for the second night of Quarterfinals (Wed), this happens year after year because of a common misunderstanding about how scheduling works: many ticket buyers erroneously assume that the second night of Quarterfinals is somehow more prestigious and will feature the best players, when in fact there's no way to predetermine which players (which half of the draw) will play on Tuesday versus Wednesday of Quarterfinals.*
